BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NUMBER 79-7.15 [REGARDING DEPARTMENT OF MARTIN COUNTY DISASTER PREPAREDNESS] WHEREAS, this Board has made the following deterinations of fact: 1. Florida Statutes 1974, Chapter 252 (State Disaster Preparedness Act) established a State Bureau of Disaster Preparedness and prescribes powers and responsibilities thereof; and, 2. Section 252.38 of said act authorizes and directs each County of this state, through its Board of County Commissioners to establish a county organization for Disaster Preparedness and prescribes the powers and responsibilities thereof; and, 3. The Resolution adopted by this Board on February 12, 1963 and amended April 25, 1967, does not now conform in wording and content with Chapter 252, as presently

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

enduted and should be revised to conform;

- A. The Martin County Board of County Commissioners hereby establishes a department of County government to be known as Martin County Disaster Preparedness Department to act in accordance with and in support of the State Civil Defense plan and program.
- B. This department shall exist and be responsible for providing effective and orderly governmental control and coordination of emergency operations in disasters and emergencies resulting from, but not limited to, enemy attack, sabotage or other hostile action, or from natural or accidental causes but not limited to, fire, flood, windstorm as provided in Chapter 252.

C. This department shall be headed by a director to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners and who shall be responsible for the organization, administration and direction of the organization and shall coordinate the activities, services, and programs for civil defense within the county and shall maintain liaison with other local governments and organizations subject only to the direction and control of this Board as provided in said statutes.

D. All of the departments, agencies, and services of Martin County government, including their employees, property, equipment and other resources which are administered by the Board of County Commissioners shall be assigned and made available to said Disaster Preparedness Department as required to effectuate the purposes of this department pursuant to statute.
