Pursuant to Section 552 of Title 5 of the United States Code and Part 9 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations promulgated thereunder, we hereby request that you make available to us for inspection and copying the following records:

1. All correspondence, memoranda, excerpts from minutes of the Subgroup on Nuclear Export Coordination, and other records generated during the period January 1, 1976 to the present, and in the possession, custody or control of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("Commission"), which relate in any way to any of the following export license applications submitted by Westinghouse Electric Corporation to the Commission: License Application No. XR-120, dated November 18, 1976; License Application No. XCOM-0013, dated August 3, 1978; License Application No. XSNM-1471, dated March 6, 1979.
2. All staff recommendations, correspondence, memoranda and other records generated during the period January 1, 1976 to the present, and in the possession, custody or control of the Commission, which relate in any way to:
  - (a) Any procedures which should be applied to applications for export licenses for facilities, components or fuel for use in a nuclear power plant.

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- (b) Any policies related to export licensing of facilities, components, or fuel for use in a nuclear power plant.
3. All other records generated during the period January 1, 1976 to the present, and in the possession, custody or control of the Commission, relating to the Philippine Power Reactor Project.


