Gentlemen:

This refers to the QA Program inspection conducted by V. L. Brownlee of this office on May 21-23, 1979, of your facility at Greenville, South Carolina, associated with the quality assurance program for construction services as applied to the J. M. Farley, V. C. Summer, S. Harris and Surry nuclear power plants and to the discussion of our preliminary findings held with H. W. McCall of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

During this inspection it was found that the implementation of your QA program failed to meet certain NRC requirements. The specific findings and references to the pertinent requirements are identified in the enclosures to this letter. Corrective actions to prevent recurrence were completed prior to the conclusion of this inspection; therefore, a reply is not requested.


