We do not generate low-level radioactive waste at this facility. The isotope used here is Bromine 82, which has a half-life of 36 hours. This material mixed with motor oil is stored at this location in two lead-lined cabinets for a minimum of 29 days. The oil is then checked with the survey meter; and if no reading is obtained, the oil is then disposed of as normal waste oil. A log is kept at this location showing the date the Bromine was activated and the date it was disposed of.
