In response to your letter of August 10, 1979 regarding IE Bulletin No. 79-19, the Laboratory Facility of PPG Industries, Inc. located at Natrium, West Virginia, does not generate any low-level radioactive waste. The Natrium Laboratory does have a NRC materials license No. 47-01542-04 covering the use of an electron capture detector. Also, license No. 45-01542-03 for our Cobalt-60 source which has been rendered completely inoperative. The source has not been used in over 10 years and will not be used again at this location.
