Dear Mr. Wilson:

We have tried, unsuccessfully, to reach you by telephone to discuss your Three Mile Island data request. We need more guidance on your data needs than your June 12, 1979 letter provided.

You should know that we provided to the Senate and the House of Representatives of Massachusetts documents which they requested as a result of the Three Mile Island accident. The documents we provided included staff reports to the Commission and formal NRC reports related to radioactive waste disposal and storage, acceptable radiation levels for employees at nuclear power plants and the surrounding populace, and the NRC safety research program. We also included a list of recent Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) hearings on reactor safety and a study done by the National Academy of Sciences on the effects on populations of exposure to low levels of ionizing radiation. You may wish to contact Mr. Edward B. O'Neill, Clerk of the Massachusetts Senate regarding these documents.

We have also supplied to the President's Commission on the Accident at Three Mile Island over 50 lineal feet of documentation in hard copy and microfiche relating to Three Mile Island.

I am enclosing for your perusal, a copy of our NUREG 0563, "Title List of Publicly Available Documents on Three Mile Island Unit 2, Docket 50-320, Cumulated to May 21, 1979." This is an interim report and an updated version should be available within the next two weeks. I will see you receive a copy of the update.

Copies of the documents listed in this report are available for review and duplication at the NRC Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20555.
