RESOLUTION NO. 79- 109

WHEREAS, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has received a request for rule making from the Critical Mass Energy Project, et al, under N.R.C. Docket No. PRM-50-23 as published in the Federal Register, Volume 44, No. 110, page 32486, dated June 6,

WHEREAS, the requested rule is arbitrary, contrary to sound emergency planning concepts, difficult to execute, and impossible to exercise and test; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Preparedness Coordinators of the affected counties in Florida have petitioned the Governor to support them in opposing the adoption of this rule by the Nuclear Regulatory

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, Collier County, Florida, did in open session on this date, support the position of the several Disaster Preparedness Coordinators in their opposition to the proposed rule.
