

The NRC letter from J. F. Stolz to T. M. Anderson (Westinghouse) dated May 15, 1979 entitled 'Review of report entitled "Qualification of Barton Pressure and Differential Pressure Transmitters"' presented the Staff evaluation of the Westinghouse qualification tests on the Barton Lot 1 transmitters as reported in NS-TMA-1950 dated September 29, 1978. The Staff evaluation letter asked for additional confirmatory qualification tests to demonstrate that the Lot 1 transmitters meet all of their design specification requirements. In response, Westinghouse proposed to the Staff a supplemental test program as described in NS-TMA-2103 dated June 21, 1979. The enclosed report contains the results of this supplemental test program.

This submittal contains proprietary information of Westinghouse Electric Corporation.
