On August 22, 1979, Natural Resources Defense Council requested the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board to issue a subpoena for Dr. Worth Bateman, Deputy Undersecretary, Department of Energy. Questions that NRDC seeks answers to from the Department of Energy through Dr. Bateman were included in the motion.

Based on conversations with Department of Energy Counsel, Staff Counsel is informed that Dr. Bateman will appear voluntarily as a witness in this proceeding if his appearance is requested by this Board. In addition, Dr. Bateman will prepare a written submittal in response to the questions set forth in the NRDC's motion $\frac{1}{}$ and, of course, will be available for questioning at the hearing by the Board and parties. The Depar ment of Energy has indicated that it will confirm these matters by a submittal to the Licensing Brard. $\frac{2}{}$
