

 - 1. The Central Minnesota Seismic Array and the Seismograph stations at Minneapolis and Warren, Minn., will be maintained and operated.
 - The analysis from records from nearby seismic events will be made to further refine the sub-surface earth model in central Minnesota with particular emphasis on defining the velocity structure more exactly.
 - 3. Assessment of the hypocenter locating capability of the array and the accuracy of the locations will be made.
 - Magnitude calibration, wave form and array processing techniques, and surface waves will be studied to develop more accurate methods and results and to delimit and explain anomalous conditions.
