This is in response to your letter of September 21, 1979, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, information concerning environmental release of radiation and radioactive materials, and occupational exposure of personnel, at the U. S. Department of Energy's uranium-enrichment plant in Portsmouth, Ohio.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has no records concerning this subject. The Department of Energy now has the responsibility for all of the old Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) records concerning this facility, as well as any new records which may have been developed since 1975, when the AEC was split into two separate agencies.
