Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

In regard to IE Bulletin 79-19 Tii Industries has ordered the necessary NRC and DOT Regulations from the Superintendent of Documents.

In 1978, eight shipments of H₃ water were sent to Teledyne Isotopes in New Jersey. Each shipment consisted of four double walled drums. Each drum containing 15 gals of water mixed with vermiculate. Total activity of these shipment was 7.24 curies.

There has been no waste generated in 1979. This due to a change in our scrubber system at present we use a plenum chamber and stack with an approximate air movement of 15,000 CFM as specified in our license.

Tii is considering other processes which might generate some waste but they will not materialize in a near future. With this in mind as soon as we receive the DOT and NRC Regulations ordered we will proceed to work in our plan of action in case any of these new developments take place.
