Dear Mr. Moul:

On August 1, 2019, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a cyber security inspection at Plant St. Lucie, Units 1 and 2. Also on August 1, 2019, the NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with Mr. Dan DeBoer, Site Director and other members of your staff.

One finding of very low safety significance (Green) is documented in this report. This finding involved a violation of NRC requirements. The inspectors also documented two licensee-identified violations which were determined to be of very low safety significance in this report. The NRC is treating these violations as non-cited violations (NCVs) consistent with Section 2.3.2.a of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the violation or significance or severity of the violation documented in this inspection report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region II; the Director, Office of Enforcement; and the NRC Resident Inspector at Saint Lucie.

If you disagree with a cross-cutting aspect assignment in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your disagreement, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region II; and the NRC Resident Inspector at Saint Lucie.
