RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF MASKS WITH MSA 88182

CARTRIDGES DURING DECONTAMINATION OF THE AUXILIARY/

FUEL BUILDING

The use of the subject equipment for respiratory protection purposes is subject to the following limitations.

- 1. Use of such equipment will not be permitted in areas where the airborne iodine-131 concentration exceeds 9 x 10⁻⁸ μ Ci/cc.
- Representative air samples will be taken during at least 20% of the work activity. The air sample shall be such that a minimum concentration of 4.5 x 10⁻⁹ µCi/cc of iodine-131 can be detected.
- Records of exposure (in MPC hours) to airborne concentrations while using the subject equipment shall be maintained for each individual.
- 4. Each individual shall be whole body counted following an accumulation of 4 MPC hours of exposure. Records of the whole body counts will be maintained.
- Evaluation of the exposure to airborne activity may be based upon whole body counts.

6. This agreement shall terminate on June 30, 1979, unless specifically extended in writing.
