During the past 24 months, Babcock, & Wilcox (B&W) of Lynchburg, Virginia has discussed its plans to build a uranium hexafluoride to uranium dioxide conversion facility at the Lynchburg site. All records pertaining to the planned conversion facility, Docket 70-1201, (now indefinitely postponed) are available by writing directly to the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555. As a result of your telephone conversation with Ms. Betty Wagman of my staff, copies of two documents pertaining to that planning effort are enclosed (see appendix). If you wish additional documents, the charge for reproducing records located in the PDR is eight cents (\$0.08) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a) of the Commission's regulations. Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Potomac Research, Inc., a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by Potomac Research, Inc. for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage. With regard to your lack of notification of NRC meetings with members of either the American Electric and Power Company or the Appalachian Power Company, your name was placed upon the proper list in February. There have been no additional meetings since that time. You will be notified for all future meetings.
