
SUBJECT: Amendment to application dated 9/24/79

The University of Illinois requests to change the period of the renewal from a 5-year period to a 10-year period. Thus the period of renewal for the Low Power Reactor Assembly (LOPRA) would be from November 1, 1979 to November 1, 1989.


The purpose of the change is to relieve the paper work that would be required for the shorter renewal period. Originally it was felt that the license should be reviewed more frequently by the local administration for continued operation. However, it is recognized that this is still possible since the License can be terminated at an earlier time should conditions warrant this decision.
