Cenclemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Spessard of this office on June 3 through June 6, 1974 at the Three Mile Island Unit. 1 Flant, Middletown, Pa. of activities authorized by ANC License Mo. DPR-50 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Spessard and other members of this office with Mr. Herbein and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Mr. Spessard and Mr. Herbein on June 14, 1974.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Operations Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of AEC requirements. The items and references to the pertinent requirements are listed in the enclosure to this letter. This letter constitutes a notice sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Gode of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office within 20 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement of explanation in reply, including: (1) corrective steps which have been or will be taken by you, and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved.
