Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Dr. Gallina of this office on February 25-27 and March 7, 1974 at the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station of activities authorized by AEC License No. CPFR-40 and to the discussions of our findings held by Dr. Gallina with Mr. J. G. Harbein, other Met Ed personnel and representatives of CPUSC on February 27 at the conclusion of the inspection at the site and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Mr. E. J. Brunner (RO:I) and Mr. Harbein on February 28, 1974. This letter also refers to the discussions held by Dr. Gallina with Messrs. Harbein, Colitz, Baer and Jencks at the conclusion of the emergency training exercise conducted on March 7, 1974.

Areas examined during this inspection included: Emergency planning and implementation procedures, emergency equipment and interface agreements with offsite agencies. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a complete examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel and personnel of off-site agencies and the observation by the inspector of an emergency training exercise.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or safety items were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the AEC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractor) believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 20 days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure. 
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contained in a separate part of the document. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
