SUBJECT: Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2 Docket Nos. 50-416 and 50-417 File 0260/0277/L-860.0/L-952.0 Amendment 34 to Application For Licenses AECM-79/130

Attached are sixty copies and three notarized originals of Amendment 34 to the Application for Licenses for Grand Gulf Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2. Amendment 34 consists of responses to second round questions; supplemental responses to first round questions; and miscellaneous refinements of design information.

Also, included is a clarification of the Grand Gulf commitment on containment and equipment loads as discussed in our August '5, 1979 meeting. Specifically, the loading definition of G. E.'s Interim Containment Loads Report (document 22A4365), Revision 2, is utilized for safety-related structures, systems and components in the containment, as amplified below:

- a. For containment structures in-phase SRV buble loading is utilized with no credit for bubble pressure reduction.
- b. General Electric Caorso data work indicates a 50% SRV bubble pressure reduction. However, for safety related piping and equipment inside containment, out-of-phase SRV bubble loading is utilized with a more conservative 35% bubble pressure reduction.

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
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
