By letter dated May 28, 2019, Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML19162A296, and as supplemented by letter dated June 14, 2019, ADAMS Accession Number ML19169A302, Greenwich Hospital Association (GHA) requested the NRC's consent to a name change on its license to Greenwich Hospital and an indirect transfer of control of NRC Materials License Number 06-09522-01. Based on the information provided, the NRC understands that Yale New Haven Health Services Corporation (YNHHS) became the sole corporate member of Greenwich Health Care Services, Inc. (GHCSI) in 1998, and at that time GHCSI was the sole corporate member of GHA. That same year (i.e., 1998), GHA amended its Certificate of Incorporation to re-name the corporate entity Greenwich Hospital. In addition, the NRC understands that in 2016, GHSCI merged with and into Greenwich Hospital (formerly GHA), with Greenwich Hospital as the surviving corporation and YNHHS as the sole corporate member. These transactions were completed without first requesting and obtaining the NRC's prior written approval as required by Section 30.34(b) of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) and section 184 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act).

The licensee's letter was effectively a request for post-hoc approval of an indirect license transfer that occurred in 1998 when YNHHS became the new corporate parent of GHA, the NRC licensee. Please note that any future transfers of control must receive prior written approval from the Commission as required by 10 CFR 30.34(b) and Section 184 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

From the above letters, we understand that this transfer did not result in a change associated with the materials; persons using licensed material; the locations, facilities, and equipment; nor the radiation safety program. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 79 documenting the requested name change.

Enclosure 2 contains Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information. Upon separation, this cover letter and Enclosure 1 is DECONTROLLED.

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Based on the above understandings, as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's safety review of the request, and in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34, the NRC consents to the proposed transfer. Proposed future changes in the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, or persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.
