
Subject EXTRA PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR  
AREA TRANSMISSION SYSTEMS FOR TMI

To RICHARD VOLLMER, NRC

Location Three Mile Island

Met-Ed company has had in place, since shortly after the accident at Three Mile Island Unit-2, around-the-clock manning at transmission substations servicing Three Mile Island.

With the completion today of the two emergency diesel generators as backup power supplies for various steam plant equipment and the completion of an additional 13.8 KV feed to the circulating water pump house, these precautionary measures are no longer necessary. We believe it is also appropriate to return our combustion turbine generators to normal economic dispatch. I request your concurrence with proceeding with the relaxation (as described in the attached memorandum) of the extra precautionary measures previously taken to assure reliable supply of power to the Three Mile Island stations.
