Re: Report on Radioactive Waste Shipments

This report is a response to the three questions contained in IE Bulletin No. 79-19.

1. Low-level radioactive waste shipments during 1978 and through June 1979. One shipment was made which consisted of 4 30 gal. drums.
2. Quantity of waste shipped - 34 mCi
Major isotopes in shipments: ^{14}C , ^3H , ^{22}Na
3. Two of the drums contained scintillation vials. They were "solidified" by adding 2 volumes of "Speedi Dry" per volume of vials in drum.

In response to your request of an audit of activities associated with radioactive waste, it may be noted that records of such activities are kept by me. Notation is made of shipment of waste drums, amount of radioactivity contained, isotopes disposed, and physical nature of waste contents. These records are always available for inspection.
