Subject: IE Bulletin No. 79-19

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the requirements of subject bulletin the following action has been taken or will be taken:

1. NRC Regulations 10CFR Chap 1 and current supplements are on file. 49CFR Parts 170-179 have been ordered.
2. Requirements of agreement states have been received from our contractor.
3. The Radiation Safety Officer and the users as specified on the license are responsible for the safe transfer and packaging of waste material.
4. Usage and handling procedures and instructions have been published and are posted at appropriate locations.
5. Periodic training and retraining have been held in the past. In the future records will be maintained for future inspections by NRC Personnel.
6. Periodic training and retraining is provided and instructions posted at appropriate locations.
7. Present Audits will be expanded to assure procedures are followed and instructions are followed.
8. An Audit signifying compliance with items 1-6 will be performed within sixty days of the date of subject bulletin.

Low level radioactive transfers for the last 18 months consisted of: 16 ea. 30 gallon barrels in three transfers. The quantity was 5.89 curies consisting of Cobalt 60, Promethium 147 and Hydrogen 3. No liquid waste was generated.
