The amendment to Part 140, which was effective on May 1, 1977, modifies the definition of "in the course of transportation" in Article I to include transportation outside the United States and supersedes the definition which included only transportation within the United States.

## AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. E-53

. 1979

AMENDMENT NO. 9

Effective May 1, 1977, Indemnity Agreement No. E-53, between The Regents of the University of California, and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated August 5, 1969, as amended, is hereby further amended by modifying the prefatory language of paragraph 4, Article I, to read as follows:

"In the course of transportation" means in the course of transportation within the United States, or in the course of transportation outs de the United States and any other nation, including handling or temporary storage incidental thereto, of the radioactive material to the location or from the location provided that:
