We have reviewed I.E. Bulletin 79-23 with regards to the Emergency Diesel Generators presently on order for North Anna Units 3 and 4. The equipment manufacturer, Colt Industries, has informed us that the excitation power transformer is to be connected to the generator leads utilizing a floating-wye primary winding configuration. Therefore, no circulating harmonic currents of the type discussed in I.E. Bulletin 79-23 can flow in this transformer. Steps will be taken to insure that this transformer primary winding is never grounded.
