NRC Names Jennifer Golder As Director, Office of Administration

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission today named Jennifer M. Golder as Director of the Office of Administration, effective December. In this role, Golder will be responsible for the agency's centralized services in the areas of acquisitions, facilities and security, property management, and administrative service.

Golder replaces Mary Muessle, who will become Director, Division of Nuclear Materials Safety, in the NRC Region IV office in Arlington, Texas.

“Jennifer is a seasoned executive with a wide range of experience in senior leadership roles,” said Margaret M. Doane, NRC Executive Director for Operations. “Her strong knowledge of business practices makes her an ideal choice for this key position. I look forward to her continued contributions to the agency’s transformation.”

Golder has held several positions at the NRC in the offices of the Chief Financial Officer and Chief Information Officer and the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Programs. Most recently, she served as Deputy Chief Human Capital Officer. Prior to joining the NRC in 1999, Golder worked at the U.S. Customs Service.

She earned a master’s degree in Public Administration from George Mason University and a Bachelor of Science degree in communications from Old Dominion University. Golder is a graduate of the NRC Senior Executive Service Candidate Development Program.

Golder will be supported by James C. Corbett, who immediately will assume the deputy director position in the Office of Administration. Corbett joined the NRC in 2002. He also is a graduate of the SES CDP.
