SUBJECT: OPERATOR STRIKE

This supplements information previously submitted in PNO 79-131.

The licensee offered a revised contract to the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) on June 2. It appears that work will continue until at least June 25, when a vote on the contract is scheduled.

There has been local media interest. Neither the licensee nor the NRC plan to issue a news release. The Commonwealth of Virginia has been informed.
