INDUSTRIAL DEATH IN SPENT FUEL POOL

At about 7:00 a.m. on April 25, a contractor employee fell into the spent fuel pool and was killed. The man fell about forty feet to the bottom of the pool which was drained for maintenance on the fuel transfer mechanisms. It is believed that the man was walking along the edge of the pool between the protective rope barricade and the edge of the pool and apparently tripped, falling over the edge. The body is slightly contaminated from surface contamination on the floor of the pool. The licensee is making arrangements to take the body to the Seven Rivers Hospital in Crystal River, Florida. Crystal River 3 was shut down for a routine refueling on April 23, 1979.

Local media interest is expected. A news release is planned by the licensee. The State of Florida and OSHA have been informed.

Region II (Atlanta) received notification of this occurrence by telephone from the on-site inspector at 8:00 a.m. on April 25.

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
