Subject: AIRPLANE ACCIDENT

The NRC resident inspector at D. C. Cook reported an airplane accident at the Benton Harbor, Michigan airport at 6:50 a.m. on February 26. A light airplane carrying a shipment of sodium-24 in carbonate firm, 0.63 curies, (Consigned to D. C. Cook from the University of Missouri) ran off the runway due to a landing gear problem. There was no injury to the pilot nor damage to the shipment. The resident inspector and a survey team from the plant reported to the airport and determined that there was no release of material as evidenced by visual and smear surveys.

The licensee has taken the shipment to the plant site.

The State of Michigan has been notified of the incident by RIII on February 26, 1979.

There has been media interest, press and radio, however, RIII does not plan a press release. RIII will respond to any inquiries by the media, press or radio.

NRC, RIII, Chicago, received notification of this incident on February 26, 1979 at 7:30 a.m. CST.
