Subject: FIRE IN AN IN-PLANT ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION

The plant experienced a fire in an in-plant electrical substation which supplied electrical power to the East Building at 12:50 p.m., on July 28, 1979. The fire was located in an area of the facility where no radioactive material is handled. The plant was on annual maintenance shutdown. No radioactive material was involved. The substation had been shut down for annual maintenance of the system and a short circuit occurred when startup of the substation was attempted. The facility emergency generator was running before, during and a er the fire and no plant systems important to safety or safeguards were affected. The fire was extinguished by the plant fire brigade.

This PN is issued for information only. No additional action by Region I is anticipated.

Media interest is possible because of local sensitivity to nuclear facility problems. The State of Connecticut has been informed. A press release is not planned by the licensee or NRC.
