Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Spessard of this office on November 26, 27 and 29, 1974 at Three Mile Island, Unit I, Middletown, Pennsylvania of activities authorized by AEC License No. DPR-50 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Spessard with Mr. Herbein of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Operations Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consi 'ed of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you had taken to correct the violation brought to your attention in a letter dated October 23, 1974, following our inspection number 50-289/74-32. We have no jurther questions regarding this matter.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of AEC requirements. The items and references to the pertinent requirements are listed in the enclosure to this letter. This letter constitutes a notice sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office within 20 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement of explanation in reply, including: (1) corrective steps which have been or will be taken by you, and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved.
