ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE
THREE MILE ISLAND - 1
RO REPORT 50-289/74-34

The licensee's response to Violation 4, "Impingement of Fish", was determined to be inadequate because (a) he stated that his interpretation of the TS does not require individual fish weights and (b) no corrective action is intended.

History

- 12/20/74 - Enforcement letter sent
- 1/21/75 - Licensee response received
- 1/22/75 - Call to NRC:RL, Environmental Project Manager for TMI to assure our interpretation is correct. Reply - Yes (Jan Norris - EP Manager)
- Call to Met-Ed, Dr. J. Mudge - he said he would have to take this up with his supervisor.
- 1/24/75 - Call to Met-Ed, Don Grace - Licensing Group, he said he would have Sandy Lawyer call.
- 1/27/75 - Call to Met-Ed, Sandy Lawyer. He said he had contacted Dave Jaffe, NRC, RL-Project Manager for TMI and Jaffe initially indicated he had same interpretation as Lawyer. Jaffe would call Environmental Projects and return call to Lawyer.
- Call to Jaffe, RL, Project Manager - TMI, he said he discussed TS with Lawyer. He needed to talk to the Environmental Project Manager and then he would return call to IE:I.
- 1/28/75 - Received call from Jaffe. He talked to Norris, Environmental Project Manager, TMI. Norris had read TS requirements in same way as IE:I inspector. Jaffe said he would get a letter from RL to Met-Ed with this interpretation within a day or two at most. Letter of interpretation was Met-Ed request.

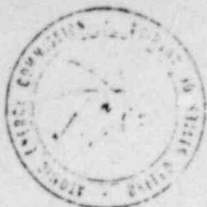
- 1/29/75 - Call to Sandy Lawyer, Met-Ed. Lawyer said that they would take no action until the letter from RL was received and could be studied. He indicated that if the interpretation of the TS required the individual fish weights, as the verbal communication from RL indicated, then individual weights would be obtained. However, until the letter is received and examined, no action would be taken. His estimate of time to respond to the letter was one to two weeks after the letter is received.
- 1/31/75 - Call to Met-Ed, Mr. R. C. Arnold, from E. J. Brunner, B. Davis, L. Spessard and R. Bores in regard to above. Arnold said he did not want to get tied down to verbal interpretation from RL, hence, he would wait for written interpretation from RL.
- 1/31/75 - Call to Dave Jaffe, RL, he said that letter of interpretation had not gone out. His management said that the letter should come from Environmental Project and that letter would probably not come within the next few days since a number of TMI environmental issues would be addressed.
