This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Folsom of this office on April 4-5, 1974 at Middletown, Pennsylvania of activities authorized by AEC License No. CPPR-40 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Folsom with Mr. Wright and Mr. Stromberg of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The areas examined during the inspection were as shown in the Regulatory Operations Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or safety items were observed.


