NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY
OPERATING LICENSE

Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 18 to Facility Operating

License No. DPR-50 issued to Metropolitan Edison Company, Jersey Central

Power and Light Company, and Pennsylvania Electric Company which revised

Technical Specifications for operation of the Three Mile Island Nuclear

Station, Unit 1, located in Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. The amendment
is effective as of its date of issuance.

The applications for the amendment comply with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment. Prior public notice of this amendment is not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.

- 2 -The Commission has determined that the issuance of this amendment will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR §51.5(d)(4) an environmental statement, negative declaration or environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment. For further details with respect to this action, see (1) the applications for amendment submitted by letters dated January 31, July 31, August 21, September 4, and October 29, 1975, and (2) Amendment No. 18 to License No. DPR-50.
