Dear Mr. Bauser:

The Atomic Energy Commission has submitted to the Office of the Federal Register for filing and publication a notice (copy enclosed) relating to the consideration of issuance of a facility operating license which would authorize the Metropolitan Edison Company, Jersey Central Power and Light Company, and Pennsylvania Electric Company, as co-licensees, to possess, use, and operate the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station Unit 1 pressurized water type nuclear power reactor on the applicants' site located in Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

As stated in the notice, reactor operation will be authorized at steady state power levels not to exceed 2535 megawatts (thermal) in accordance with the provisions of the license and the Technical Specifications appended thereto, upon the submission of a favorable safety evaluation of the application by the Directorate of Licensing, the completion of the environmental review required by the Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix D and a finding by the Commission that the application for the facility license (as amended) complies with the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Chapter 1.
