AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-51

AMENDMENT NO. 9

Effective May 1, 1977, Indemnity Agreement No. B-51, between Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company, and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated ugust 9, 1971, as amended, is hereby further amended by modifying the refatory language of paragraph 5, Article I, to read as follows:

"In the course of transportation" means in the course of transportation within the United States, or in the course of transportation outside the United States and any other nation, including handling or remporary storage incidental thereto, of the radioactive material to the location or from the location provided that:
