Subject: BOMB THREAT

On August 24, 1979 at 8:00 p.m. PDT, an unknown male called the Pullman Power Products' office at the Diablo Canyon Unit No. 1 site and stated a bomb was to go off at 8:30 p.m. in the pipe racks of Unit No. 1 between the Containment and Turbine Buildings. Pullman Power Products' employees were advised of the threat and all elected to leave the site. A search of the site was conducted with negative results. Media interest is not expected by the licensee, and no press ralease is planned. The State of California has been notified.

Site Construction progress is currently reported as 99% complete for Unit No. 1 and approximatley 98% for Unit 2. Fuel is on site.

The IAT has been notified.
