Subject: BOMB THREAT

At 5:05 a.m. on June 27, 1979, an unidentified male called the Wackenhut security office at the Surry construction site and stated, "Your place is going to blow up in a half an hour". The Wackenhut security office was evacuated, searched, and nothing was found. No other facilities were evacuated or searched. Unit No. 1 is not operating due to steam generator replacement. Unit 2 is not operating due to steam generator replacement.

Media interest is not anticipated. A news release is not planned by the licensee or the NRC. The licensee notified the Surry County Sheriff. The Commonwealth of Virginia has been informed.

The IAT was notified.
