
We have reviewed the environmental report for the Olge Petroleum, Inc., in Situ Uranium Mine, Fremont County, Wyoming.

The report is very well prepared and adequately presents the significant aspects of the Situ operation. We would, however, want to review the environmental statement when it is prepared to ascertain any adverse impacts to the Indian land and people of the Wind River Indian Reservation.
