As per our many conversations in the past seven months concerning this Source Materials License (SNA-1199), I would like to submit this request to cancel this license and to close out our Docket File No. 40-8200. Enclosed you will find a report giving the post-operational findings and an historical review of all activities at this site.

As per the report this site was closed in May, 1975 with the post-test sampling by Wyoming Mineral. Since that time Cliffs has tried unsuccessfully to get W.M.C. to establish the proper data. Finally in 1977 Cliffs assumed a licensed owner responsibility and proceeded to establish the present conditions and restore the site.

The enclosed report should explain past and present conditions of the R&D site. Should any other questions or further information be required, please contact this office.
