SUBJECT: BOMB THREAT

At 8:31 a.m. on May 25, 1979 an anonymous telephone call was received by the onsite telephone operator. A male stated "There is a bomb in the plant set to go off at 9:30 a.m." The plant site was evacuated and a search initiated with negative results. The licensee notified the local law enforcement agency. All units are under construction and no fuel is on site.

Media interest is anticipated. A news release is not planned by the licensee or the NRC. The State of North Carolina has been informed.
