SUBJECT: SCHEDULE FOR SUBMITTAL OF THE WESTINGHOUSE OWNERS' GROUP  
ANALYSIS OF ACCIDENTS AND TRANSIENTS.

Your letter of September 2, 1979 indicated a required completion date of January 1, 1980 for the analyses of transients and accidents (NUREG - 0578, Item 2.1.9c) and Owners' Group letter OG-15 dated October 29, 1979 indicated that the Westinghouse Owners' Group would meet this date.

Subsequent to the above reference, D. G. Eisenhower's letter of September 13, 1979, and H. Denton's letter of October 30, 1979 to all operating plants both specified that the completion date for this effort is "Early 1980". The Owner's Group interprets "Early 1980" to mean by the end of the first quarter in 1980.

The Owner's Group believes that this type of analysis effort has a potential impact on operating procedures and training programs and that the January 1, 1980 target date will not permit ample time for a thorough review of the results by all Owners' Group members before submittal to the NRC. Therefore, the Westinghouse Owners' Group will submit its analyses of accidents and transients to the NRC by March 31, 1980 which is consistent with the most recent NRC specified schedule of early 1980.
