On June 20, 2019, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at your Rancho Seco Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation. Based on subsequent communications with your staff, the NRC has confirmed an error in the NRC Inspection Report No. 072-00111/2019401, dated July 25, 2019 (Agencywide Document Access Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML19206A587). Specifically, the report had an inaccurate statement within the inspection scope in the report details section. The NRC has reissued the report in its entirety to correct this error.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS).
