Gentlemen:

This concerns our review of the revised physical security plan - Morris Operation, NEDS 14507C dated September 1978 transmitted by your letter of October 12, 1978 as amended by your letter of October 15, 1978.

We have determined that your revised plan as amended is acceptable. Because this revision incorporates the requirements of most of the license conditions, we are rescinding in its entirety Section 1.0 and Appendix A of Materials and Plant Protection Amendment MPP-3 to your License No. SNM-1265 and reissuing Section 1.0 as contained in the enclosure to this letter, effective upon receipt.

Please note that Condition 1.1 of the Security Plan includes the alphabet suffix. This is a necessary control requirement as discussed in a telephone conversation between your Mr. H. A. Rogers and Mr. G. S. Podonsky, of the NRC staff on December 21, 1978.

We have established that the enclosure to your October 12, 1978 letter contains information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.

1.0 Facility Security
