On March 2, 1979, Mississippi Power & Light Company notified Mr. J. K. Rausch of your office of a potential reportable deficiency at the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station construction site concerning the failure of a switch assembly installed in the 4.16 KV switchgear. We had anticipated that by May 30, 1979, sufficient data would be available for us to determine reportability as defined by 10CFR 50.55(e). However, due to additional analyses required, we wish to extend our date for determining reportability until July 13, 1979.
