The Northern California Power Agency ("NCPA") requests an additional extension of time in order to respond to Pacific Gas and Electric Company's ("PG&E") most recent set of interrogatories. 1/

Currently, NCPA's responses are due on September 28, 1979. NCPA seeks additional time due to the fact that its attorneys as well as certain consultants whose assistance is necessary to answer these interrogatories have been involved in continually ongoing proceedings before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in Docket No. E-7777(II). Participation in these proceedings has resulted in very limited amounts of time being available to focus on and respond to PG&E's most recent set of interrogatories. In addition, NCPA seeks additional time to obtain the information requested by PG&E in those interrogatories. Counsel for PG&E has stated that he does not object to an extension of time until October 15, 1979 for NCPA to submit any objections it has to this set of interrogatories and to
