Gentlemen:

On August 18, 1978, the Commission issued Amendment No. 17 to Operating License DPR-64 which authorized operation of the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 3 (Indian Point 3) at 100% power. As required by 10 CFR 170.21, an operating license fee of \$1,024,500 was paid for the issuance of the operating license.

In accordance with Footnotes 1 and 3 of Section 170.21, the costs incurred in the processing and issuance of the Indian Point 3 operating license have been reviewed and they substantially exceed the maximum fee of \$1,024,500 prescribed by the Commission's regulations. Since the maximum fee prescribed by regulation for an operating license has been paid, no additional operating license fee is required for Indian Point 3.
