Dear Mr. Harrison:

As discussed with Ken Green of the State Programs Emergency Preparedness staff, you will be receiving a draft of an "example plan" for a response by a fictional locality, Brownville, in the event there is a radiological accident at a nearby nuclear power station. This draft was prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the purpose of providing guidance to localities preparing to respond to such an accident. It would be very useful to us if you could respond by Monday, December 17, 1979, with a written evaluation of the FEMA draft.

We would like your evaluation to include other members of the Region IV Advisory Committee. To the extent possible, the evaluation should be done in the same manner and using the same criteria (NUREG-75/111) as you use in evaluation State and local pians for concurrence.
