This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. F. J. Jablonski and H. S. Phillips of this office on October 15, 1979, of activities at Bailly Nuclear Generating Station authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-104 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. R. J. Bohn and others of the Bailly staff at the conclusion of the inspection.
