SUBJECT: BROOKHAVEN NATIONAL LABORATORY (BNL) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
ON THE MARK I CONTAINMENT ASSESSMENT TO THE DIVISION OF
OPERATING REACTORS

This letter provides guidance and funding to BNL to support the Division of Operating Reactors in the evaluation of Mark I Containment Suppression Pool Hydrodynamic Loads. The scope of work and schedule for this program remain unchanged from that specified in our letter of November 16, 1978, as supplemented by our letter of May 2, 1979. The FY 1979 CH Financial Plan should be modified to include an additional \$60,000 for this work under B&R 20 19 04 032, FIN A3108. This funding increase is necessary to provide sufficient resources to complete the original work scope.
